Heroes of Green Future, Scenario (English)

Setting: Fthiotida, Greece – A picturesque blend of mountains, sea, and quaint villages.

Theme: Climate action through the lens of the European Green Deal, tailored to engage and inspire children.

The Problem Begins

A sunny day in Fthiotida, where children are hanging out with Mount Knimis in the background. Suddenly, a dark cloud approaches, and the trees begin to wilt while the air turns hazy. The narrator introduces the problem, highlighting the dangers of climate change and its impact on the environment.

Meet the Heroes

Three children—Orestis, Eleni, and Nikolas—observe the environmental changes in their village. They encounter a wise, magical owl named Athena, who informs them that the European Green Deal offers hope, but collective action is necessary.

Learning About Greenhouse Gases

Fthiotida- Hidden Treasures

Athena reveals that Fthiotida possesses valuable natural resources—sunlight, wind, and fertile land—that can be harnessed for clean energy. The children excitedly realize that these resources can be used to create sustainable solutions. The team resolves to take action.

Solar Power Adventure

The children visit a local farm and propose installing solar panels. The farmer agrees, recognizing the benefits of energy conservation and cost reduction. Athena illustrates how solar energy functions through a magical sunbeam.

Wind Turbine Challenge

The children climb a hill and identify an ideal location for wind turbines and decide to convince the local community. Athena commends their initiative, encouraging them to continue.

Recycling Mission

As they are taking a stroll to their favourite place, they spot litter by the river, thus deciding to organize a cleanup and establish a recycling center. Athena rewards their efforts with seeds to plant trees, reinforcing the importance of reforestation.

Planting Trees

The children plant trees in a deforested area. they have learned in school that trees absorb CO2 and contribute to cleaner air. Their efforts succeed. Gradually, the landscape begins to rejuvenate.

Spreading the Word

The children arrange a community meeting to share their achievements and motivate others to participate. Athena emphasizes that collective efforts ensure no one and no place is left behind.

The children provide practical energy-saving advice, such as turning off unused lights and using efficient appliances. They suggest walking or biking instead of using cars. Community acknowledges that small actions lead to significant change.

Athena presents a vision of Fthiotida in 2050—a thriving landscape with spinning wind turbines, gleaming solar panels, and a pristine river. The children celebrate their success in shaping a sustainable future.

A Bright Green Future

A festival is organized to celebrate green accomplishments.

The children, Athena, and the villagers stand together in a revitalized Fthiotida. As Athena takes flight, she encourages them to continue safeguarding their home, reminding them that the planet's well-being depends on their efforts. Athina also affirms that, with the European
